RMSAAM's response to Covid-19

Covid-19, we want to reassure our students that we are doing all that we can to keep you informed and safe during this time. Our focus is on your welfare, education and as always on supporting the animals.

As an accredited trade school, we are governed by the Colorado Department of Higher Education under the Division of Private Occupational Schools. They have issued a statement instructing us on the policy/protocols required during the Covid-19 situation. Our classes have been allowed to resume as of June 1 as long as we follow the CDC's safety and social distancing recommendations. We are following proper sanitation guidelines and sanitizing class room space at the end of each day, there are sanitizing stations located at each door and in the restrooms, masks and gloves are available for students to use, we have no more than 10 people in an area with 6' of separation between them. Our classes contain no more than 8 students.

We have implemented some new options for students who do not feel comfortable with attending classes on campus. Our correspondence classes are available as an option.

Enrollment options as of June 1, 2020

All On Campus classes on the schedule are open for enrollment.
Correspondence classes are completely web-based and open for enrollment.

*If for any reason a student wishes to change from a correspondence to an on campus class or vice versa, we are waiving all change fees through the end of the year.

We recognize that many students are kinesthetic learners and prefer to attend a class in-person to gain hands-on experience. If you enrolled in a correspondence class because of the Covid-19 threat, and would like some in-person, hands-on instruction, we want to make sure your needs are being met by offering a new class. Starting in August, we are offering a practicum weekend. Students can attend this 2-day class on campus for no additional charge. This would allow you to ask questions, do anatomy labs and practice massages with an instructor guiding you. Please check our calendar for options.
